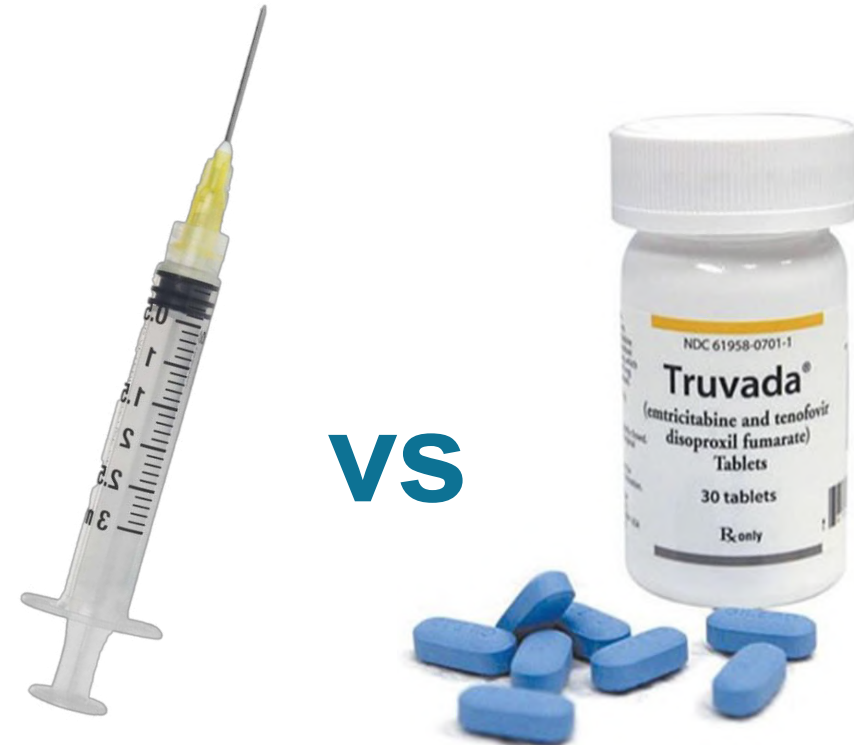


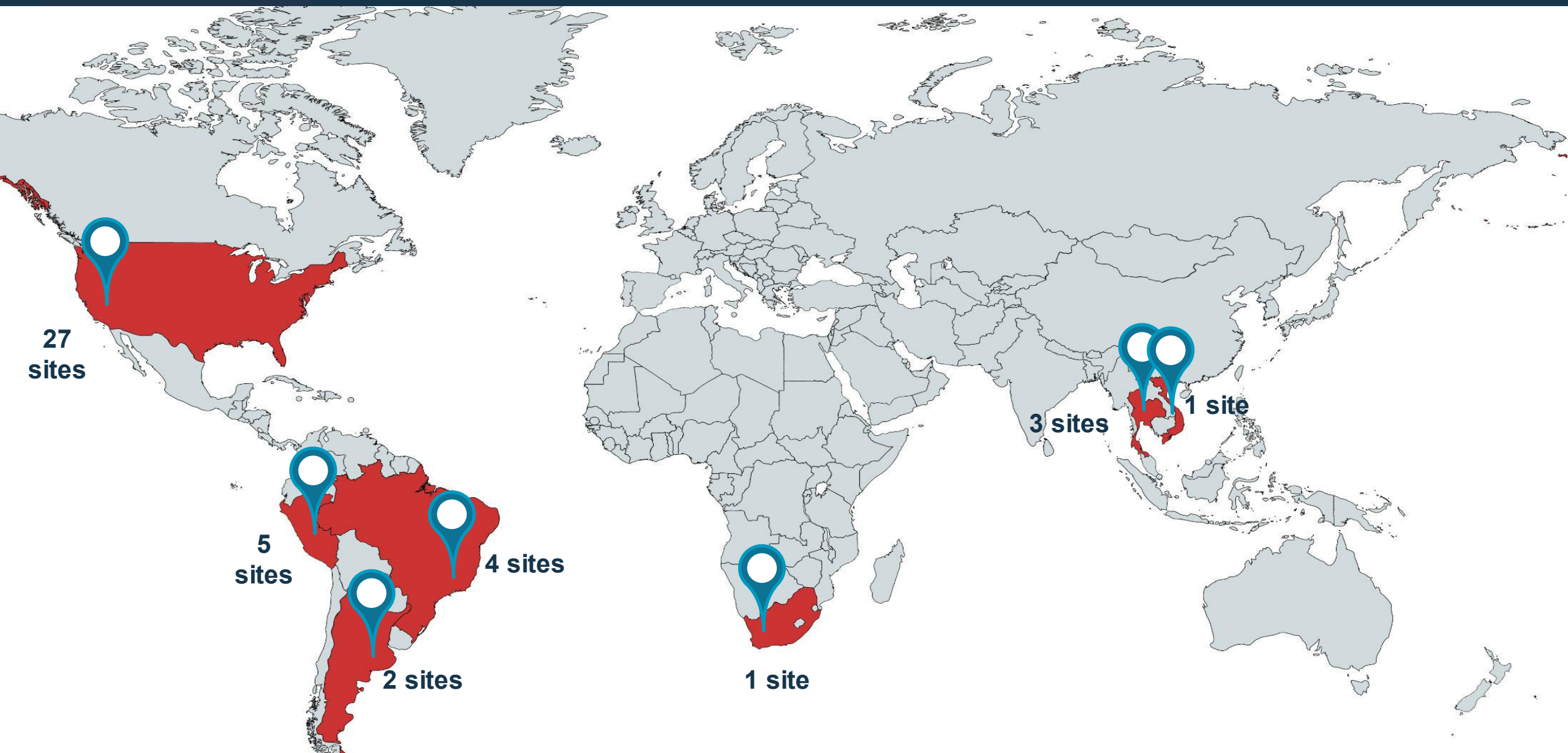
Cisgender Young MSM | Transgender Women | Cisgender Black MSM | 4 Regions

HPTN 083 RECRUITMENT OVERVIEW

HPTN 083 Study Design

- Phase 2b/3 trial
- Randomized, double-blind, double dummy
- Daily oral Truvada vs. cabotegravir
- Non-inferiority with pre-specified superiority
- 5000 cisgender men and transgender women who have sex with men
- 43 sites in 7 countries





Study Targets

Recruitment Targets		
Population	Target	Actual
Under the Age of 30	50%	66%
Transgender Women	10%	12%
Black or African American in the US	50%	50%

Retention	
Time Point	Total
Month 6	91%
Month 12	87 %
Month 18	80%
Month 24	74%

BEST PRACTICES FOR COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Community Working Groups

- Enhance community strategies and/or identify possible challenges
- Development of Community Engagement work plans prior to study activation
- Assist in the development of study-specific educational tool kits and communication plans
- Inform community members of protocol updates, site-specific community involvement activities
- Conduct community preparedness and ongoing involvement activities
- Forum for sharing best practices

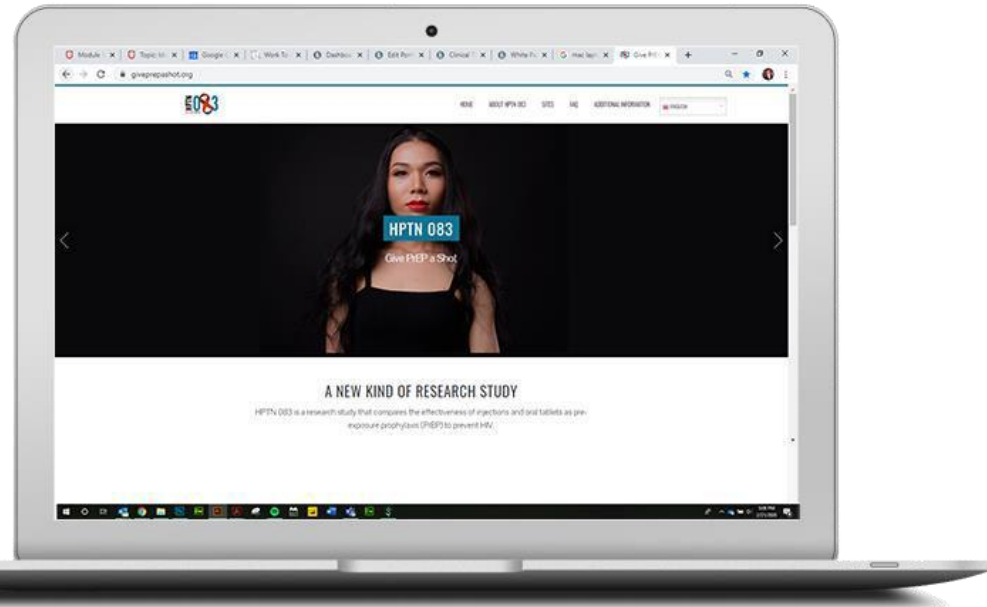

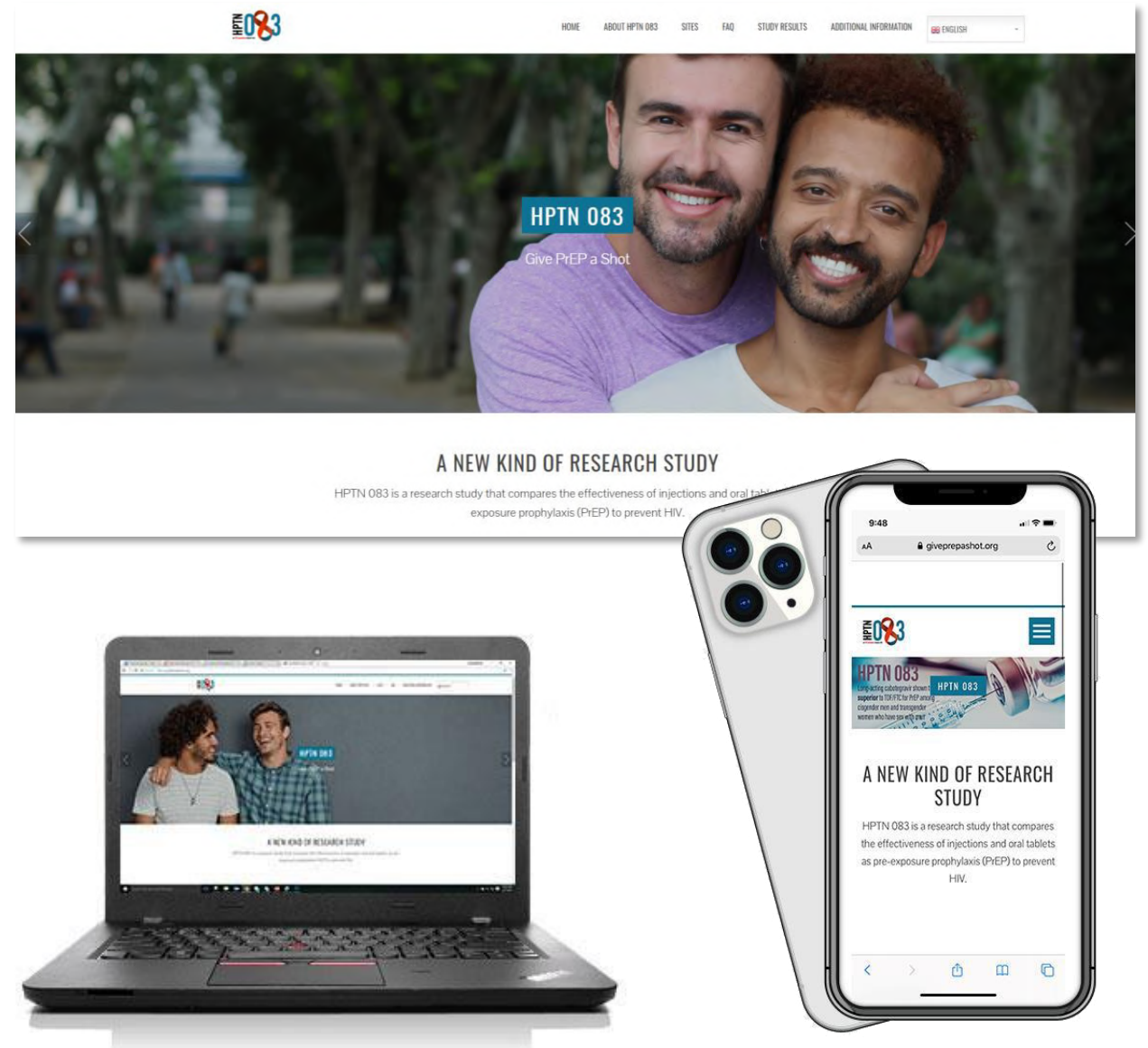
